

KCGameOn Infectious Disease Policy

Purpose: This Policy is intended to prevent the spreading or outbreak of communicable or infectious diseases and will be interpreted and administered in order to protect the health and well-being of the KCGameOn community.

Definition: “Infectious Disease” is defined as a disease of humans or animals resulting from an infection or an illness due to exposure to a specific disease agent which arises through transmission of that disease agent, either directly or indirectly, including but not limited to, hepatitis A, B and C, HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, Rubella, chicken pox, influenza, measles, meningitis and others as may be identified by the Centers for Disease Control, the Kansas Department of Health and Environment and the Johnson County Health Department.

Statement: It is the intent of the KCGameOn to comply with all applicable federal and state laws in connection with an individual who contracts an Infectious Disease. Attendees and volunteers are encouraged to immediately report information related to the potential occurrence of an infectious disease within the KCGameOn community. In the event of an infectious disease in the KCGameOn community, KCGameOn will review and monitor the situation on a case-by-case basis and work with local, state and federal authorities, as necessary, to determine the appropriate course of action.

As permitted by law, KCGameOn may take steps to identify and address potential infectious diseases, including but not limited to the following:

- Maintain the confidentiality of and/or disclose the identity and other information regarding the infectious disease as may be required by law;
- Follow guidance or directives from local, state or federal authorities;
- Implement other temporary action(s) that is reasonably required to prevent unacceptable risk of exposure to the KCGameOn community.
- Removal of any attendee or volunteer from the event if KCGameOn administration feels like the person in question is at risk of spreading illness of any kind.
